## SURNAME INDEX PROJECT

The first edition of our surname index was printed in May and has been distributed to many of our members. Those members who have not received a copy should expect one in the near future. Several readers reported successful "connections" as a result of this first index. All members are invited to submit up to 15 surnames for inclusion in our surname directory. This index will be available to all members, and updated annually. The index is sorted not only alphabetically, but also by places and time periods. This will allow members who are interested in a particular locale to join efforts, even though they may not be working on the same family.

The index is expensive to mail, time-consuming to prepare, and the content does not require frequent editing. However, since new members are being added at such a rate, we will publish another 1986 version, probably in late October. Any surname information received after September 15, 1986 will not be published until late 1987.

If you wish to revise or add to cards already submitted, please do so by September 15. Please note your cards as "REVISION" or "ADDITIONS". If you submitted surnames before the last publication deadline, and your information does not appear in the May index, please notify C. Adams.

These notices were collected by Daniel De Noyelles, Sr., Historian of the Town of Haverstraw. The indexes were compiled by Marie Koestler, Genealogy Researcher for the HSRC.

The notices are on file in the library at the Historical Society, and may be viewed by permission of the librarian. The complete index is also available there.

There are more than 1500 notices, and so publication will be in several successive issues of the newsletter. We believe that the publication of previously unavailable information such as this is in perfect keeping with the aims and goals of the GSRC, and therefore justifies the additional size of the newsletter, and the additional postage. In some cases, I have found it necessary to abbreviate the listings slightly, in order to fit the newsletter format.

# ~~~~~ GERMAN EMIGRATION SOURCE

According to an article published  
in The (Bergen) Record Aug. 4, 1985;  
the city of Hamburg, West Germany  
is working to establish itself as  
an authority on 19th century  
German emigration.

This north German port city's  
tourism division has established  
the Historic Emigration Office in  
hopes of attracting American  
tourists to Hamburg.

Hamburg possesses the only surviving German ship records of the mass wave of 19th-century emigrations by Germans and other Europeans.

The Historic Emigration Office is located at the Hamburg History Museum. It uses 274 microfilms supplied by the state archives of the original passenger lists for the 1850-1914 and 1919-1926 periods. The lists contain five million names.

In addition to servicing visitors to the Museum, the office has handled thousands of mail requests for research assistance.

As of 1985 the charge was 75 marks (about \$30) for each year searched. The exact year of emigration facilitates a successful search.

There are some other research problems frequently encountered by the searcher. Common names are a real problem. It is often difficult to establish a definite connection to the right Schmidt, Mueller, etc.

Also, many Germans emigrated from Bremen, Le Havre, Antwerp or Rotterdam. These records only pertain to departures from Hamburg.

The records are arranged only approximately in alphabetical order, and so very careful searching is required.

Even with these problems, the co-director of the office, Michael Vogel states that if a person can supply the exact year that an ancestor left, the success rate for the search is approximately 30%.



It is important to remember that many non-Germans departed from Hamburg, and so this office may provide assistance in tracking non-German ancestors as well. For example, 2.3 million Jews used Hamburg to emigrate from Eastern Europe between 1885 and 1938.

## IRISH-AMERICAN HISTORICAL SOCIETY
