Stated her intention of responding to query by member J. Horak... thanked us for running her queries, and sent samples of publication covers from the Maine Genealogical Society Newsletter.

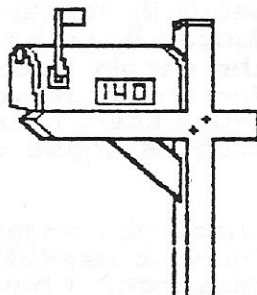
FROM SUSAN SANDERS, PLAINWELL, MI -

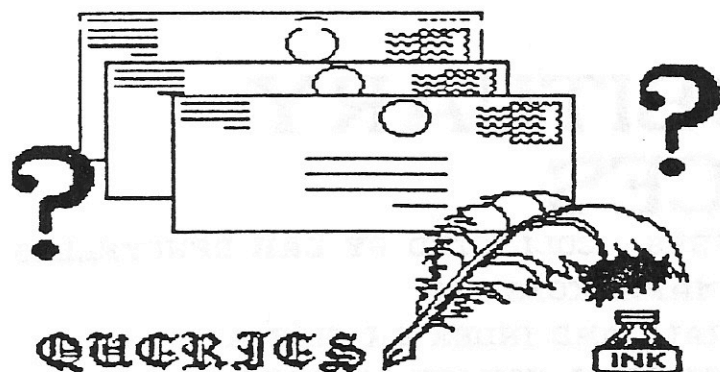

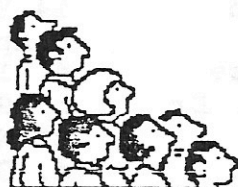

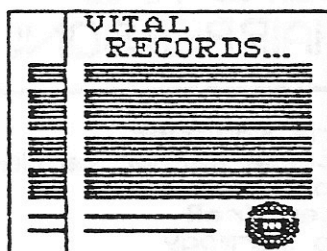

Town/Village Requirements:

1. Proof of relationship to the named person/persons on the certificate.
2. For birth certificates - a death certificate is required.
3. Supply the name and date of person for whom certificate is requested.

office.

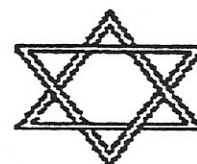
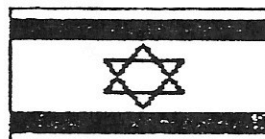

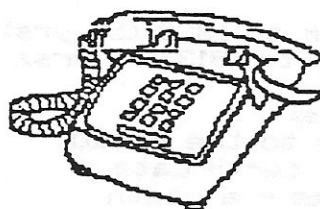
