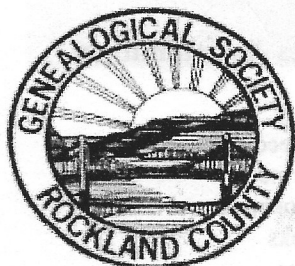

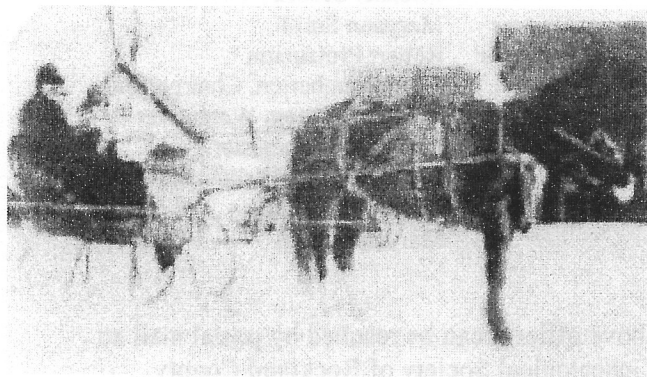

## ANCESTOR TABLES

In order to increase interaction between members, the society will continue to publish Ancestor Tables submissions, which are brief listings of the ancestry of members. It is hoped that members will find distant cousins who share common lines, which will further the research efforts of us all. All members are encouraged to submit their Ancestor Tables to the Ancestor Table Editor, Bob Protzmann, 4 Ethel Drive, New City, NY 10956-6328, or by E-mail, in WORD, or .txt format to [Protzy41@optonline.net](mailto:Protzy41@optonline.net).

**PLEASE NOTE:** - The accuracy of information presented in Ancestor Tables is the responsibility of the submitters, and not the responsibility of the Genealogical Society of Rockland County. Please do not submit information that is not documented. If there is any uncertainty, the information should be marked with a "?" Anyone who desires further information, documentation, or has questions or additional information, should contact the submitter at his address given at the head of the Table.

Additional data should be sent to the submitter, and copied to the Ancestor Table Editor, at the address noted above. We will publish comments and corrections, etc., in the Ancestor table Forum.

The numbering system used is as follows: The first person on the list is number 1. Each ancestor's father is twice that person's number. Each wife is one number higher than her husband. If all ancestor's were known, then all numbers would be used. When an ancestor is unknown, the number is skipped. The number in parentheses after each generation is the number of ancestors in that generation. A (♦) indicates the last known ancestor in that line. A (\*) indicates that the individual occurs more than once in the ancestry, \*\* indicates the second listing for the individual.

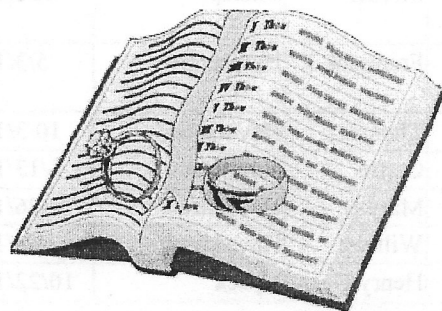

For the period of a year or more, GSRC members: Joan Brooks, Marie Koestler and Maryann Smith made regular trips to the NYS Archives in Albany to copy the indexes of the BMDs held there. Some help was also provided by Joe Montelione and Bob Protzman. We were moving right along when winter came and weather too frequently interfered and then we were really stymied by the gasoline crisis. Hence, were at least temporarily, put out of business. We had been searching the microfiche specifically for the residents of Rockland County towns and villages. The information provided a certificate number or license or registration number along with name, date of event, and township. In some instances this data is sufficient for our needs, but when the full document is required, this index information completed on the State's form, will save you both time and money to procure the document. Your request will not need to go on the bottom of a pile which may reach the top a year or more later and no one will have to go through the records searching for the name(s). You are just providing information that you obtained from the Albany NYS Archives. Please see form and Instructions on pages 29 and 30.

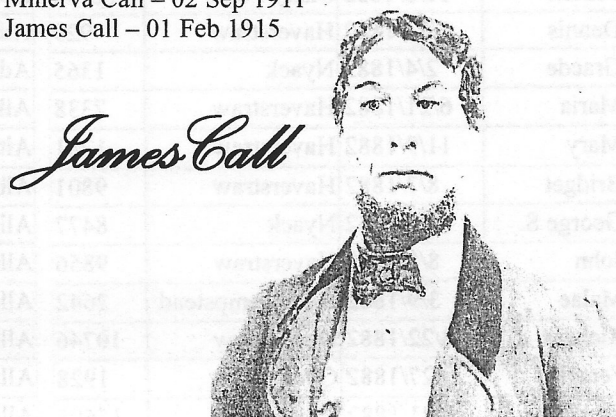

## FROM OUR MEMBERS

Dear GSRC Editor,

I read the President's Message in the September 2008 Newsletter about brick walls. My brick wall is for my ancestor Jacob Conklin b.1763 in Orange County, probably in the area that is now Rockland County. I have sent this same Bible record to the Orange County Genealogical Society for their Newsletter.

This Jacob Conklin Bible information was printed in two issues of the DAR Magazine (I do not have the Bible). I have printed the bible record exactly as it was printed in the DAR magazines, but I have discovered some corrections in my research of the family.

I have shared the detailed information of my Jacob Conklin line with descendants of the Armstrong family who have posted the details on-line, so this Jacob Conklin information is available when searching WorldConnect for example.

My Brick Wall is the location of Jacob Conklin b.1790 in Orange (Rockland) County prior to 1820 when Jacob Conklin and father James and brother James (Jr) b.1800 moved to Owego, Tioga, NY. Jacob married Joanna (AKA Johanna) Armstrong, from Florida, Orange, NY, on Sept 10, 1814 - location unknown. James and his sons were all wagon makers - residence unknown. I believe that James (Sr) had other children between 1790 and 1800 who remained in Orange County after 1820. I am hoping publishing this Jacob Conklin Bible record in your next newsletter might help other Conklin researchers with their brick wall, and might help me with mine.

This CONKLIN Family Bible information, has been printed in the DAR Magazines in December 1984, pages 786-788 and March 2000, pages 174-180. DAR Magazine has said that they do not know who submitted this information.

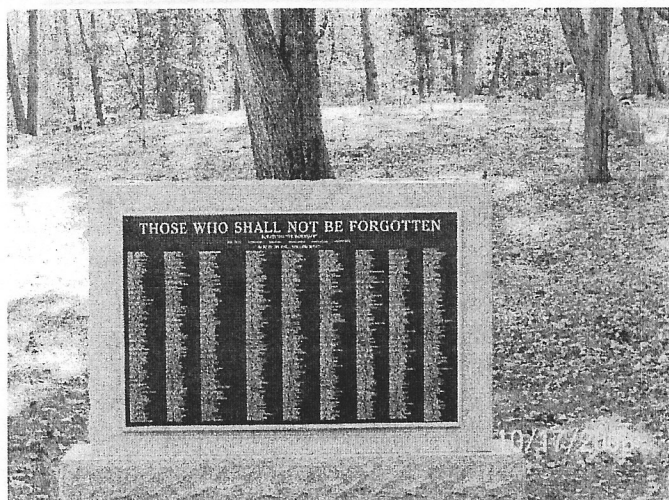

### MEMORIAL REMEMBRANCE TO LETCHWORTH RESIDENTS BURIED ANONYMOUSLY

A Bronze Memorial plaque was placed at the Old Letchworth Village Cemetery, Call Hollow Road, Thiells in August. The State plans to hold a memorial dedication in the spring of 2009. After many months of searching the records for names to go with the 910 small T-shaped metal markers with numbers, Jacqueline Ferrara, ombudsman for the Hudson Valley Developmental Disabilities Services Office, has succeeded. The names that go with the numbers are listed on the plaque in rows in the order of the deaths of these former Letchworth residents.

"Those Who Shall Not Be Forgotten" is written on the plaque in an attempt to atone for the past wrongs. In addition to the names of those buried from December of 1917 through 1967, there are six former residents buried on Cheesecote Mountain in Haverstraw from 1914 to 1917. The site is unknown and unmarked.

Senator Thomas Morahan introduced the legislation that allows the OMRDD to release the names and dates of birth and death of any patient who lived in one of the states facilities for the purpose of inscribing a headstone.

People with developmental disabilities and mental illnesses, orphans, the homeless and those deemed unmanageable were sent to Letchworth during most of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. In many cases, parents hid the fact that they had a child with disabilities; they did not let other members of the family know about the child. They were told to bring them to Letchworth and forget about them.

Thanks to Miss Ferrara, the 910 people buried at the old cemetery at Letchworth are now remembered by name. Charter Member Mrs. Tom Dater (Joan) of Mahwah, NJ, has reprinted "The Etiquette Book of 1854."

The original copy of the book was given to Mary Dater Ryerson as a young woman. Prominent in the Civil War politics of Ramsey, the Dater's lived downtown and had their general store at the Plaza parking lot, later in the building that now houses Brady's. The Dater Mansion once stood at the strip that houses Krauser's and adjacent stores on East Main Street.

The book gives insights into how Ramsey residents went about their daily lives and what expectations they had for each other. It sheds light on a time when elegance and grace were the order of the day. How local residents conducted themselves has much to say to our current, local culture.

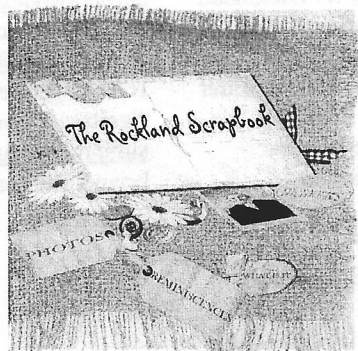

### **The Pleasure Palace in Haverstraw**

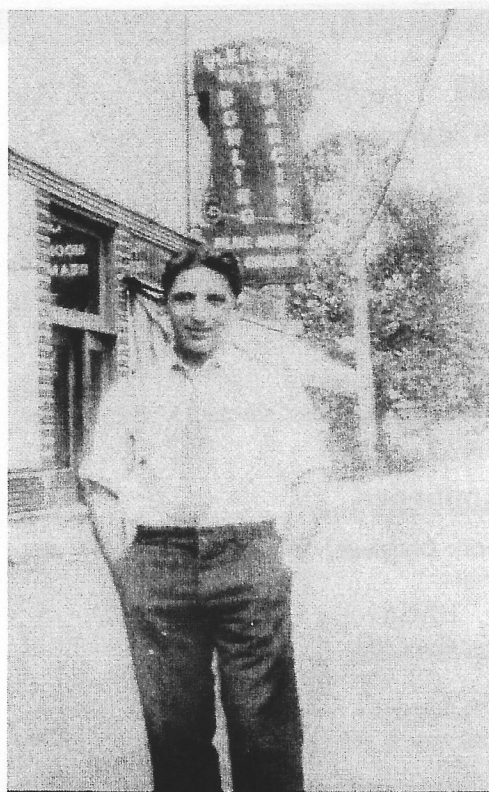

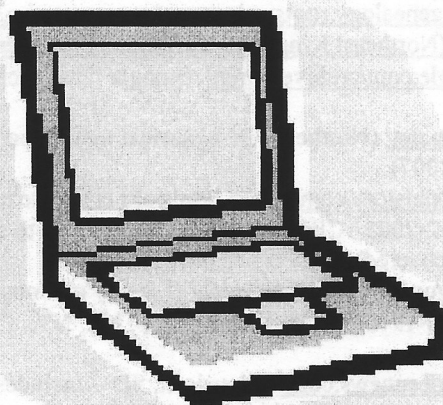

**General Instructions**

- Use this application only for *genealogy requests*.
- Print a copy of this application, complete and sign.
- **Mail** application with check or money order and a copy of any required documentation (see below) to:

**Fees:** If no record is on file, a **No Record Report** will be issued and the fee is **not** refunded.

- **For standard search:** This includes a three (3) year search. The fee is \$22.00 per copy. The fee is for **each** name or type of record requested.
- **For long search:** When more than a three-year search is requested, the fee for each record in need of a longer search is higher according to the following schedule:

1 - 3 years	\$22.00	31 - 40 years	\$102.00
4 - 10 years	\$42.00	41 - 50 years	\$122.00
11 - 20 years	\$62.00	51 - 60 years	\$142.00
21 - 30 years	\$82.00	61 - 70 years	\$162.00

The fee applies separately to each record requested. For example, the fee for a request consisting of one birth record (1-year search), plus one death record (24-year search), plus one marriage record (11-year search) is a total of \$166.00 (\$22 + \$82 + \$62 = \$166)

- Send check or money order payable to the New York State Department of Health. Do not send cash.

**Note:** Payment submitted from foreign countries must be made by a check drawn on a United States bank or by international money order. **Do not send cash.**

**Available Records**

- No information shall be released from a record unless the person to whom the record relates is known to the applicant to be deceased.
- No information shall be released unless the record has been on file for a minimum required period: birth records must have been on file for at least 75 years, death records for 50 years, marriage records for 50 years (both parties to the marriage must be deceased).
- The time periods above are waived if the applicant is a descendant and provides documentation of direct line descent. A party acting on behalf of a descendant shall further provide documentation that the descendant authorized the party to make such application.

**Completing the Form**

- If you are using Adobe Reader® 5.0 or newer (available as a free download from [www.adobe.com](http://www.adobe.com)) you can fill in the form directly in Adobe Reader by clicking on the appropriate space and entering the information (use the TAB key to move to the next field, shift-TAB to move backwards). Print the completed form, sign and mail to the address shown above.
- You can print out a blank copy of the form and then type or print the required information.
- Be sure to sign the form before mailing and include a check or money order made payable to the New York State Department of Health along with copies of any required documentation.
