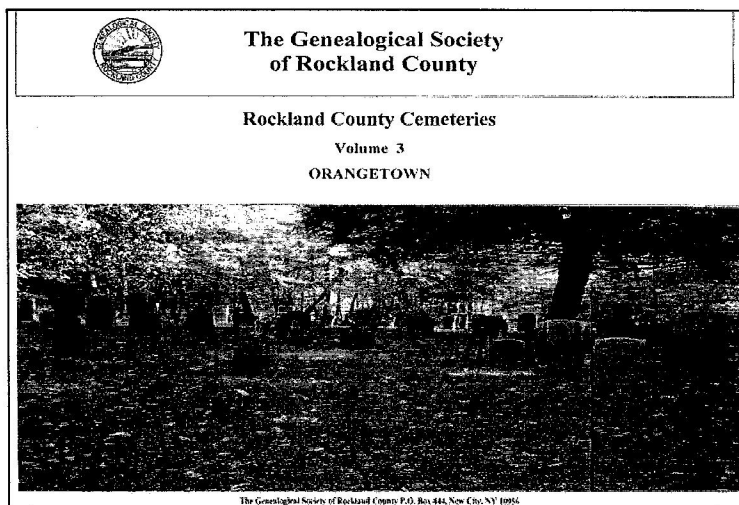
Despite being a little flaky at times, he still was a crusty old man and was considered a positive roll model for millions.
