Rockland County Weather Data - 1709-1909

Brian Belanger

A compilation of Rockland County weather events and their effects on specific residents, spanning the years 1709 to 1909, has been posted at <http://rocklandgenealogy.org> for use as a genealogical tool. Without wall insulation, enclosed vehicles, or air conditioning, our early ancestors were often at the mercy of the weather. As a largely agricultural community, Rockland County residents relied on favorable weather conditions to grow crops that provided food and income. In the absence of pesticides and immunizations, insect populations and the spread of disease were also greatly influenced by temperature and moisture availability. When gathering significant dates in your ancestors' lives, consider the environmental conditions that accompanied, or even caused, personal experiences. Putting individuals in the context of their surroundings allows a series of dry facts to become an interesting narrative that even a non-genealogist might enjoy reading. My 3rd great grandfather, Casper Zorn, died of pneumonia in Mt. Ivy after tending to his sick horse. Weather data revealed that the winter of 1911 was particularly harsh and supplied details that allowed me to paint a more complete picture of the conditions that contributed to his death. Hopefully, this weather directory will provide family historians with a central reference that can be used to enhance the biographies of ancestors who have enjoyed and endured climatic events during the course of two centuries in Rockland County.

GSRC Program 25 September 2012

"We Are Orangetown," a 2011 "picture book" printed by Arcadia Publishing for The Orangetown Historical Museum & Archives. It contains approximately 250 photographs, with captions, of buildings and/or scenes of historical interest in the hamlets that make up Orangetown, New York. Many of the photographs have not been previously published.

The program was presented by Mary Cardenas, Orangetown Historian with: Paul Clark and Rosemarie Raccioppi. Rosemarie read a poem reflecting each of the ten communities that make up Orangetown. A slide show followed that included:

Tappan: the Mock's residence – farmhouse built in 1845 by the McGillicuddy's; a 1914 view of King's Highway/ Main Street; Oak Tree Road where the Tar Barrel Tree stood during Revolutionary times; views of the collapsed Casparus Mabie House aka '76 House, before its restoration by Mary Anne and Charles Pike.

Palisades & Snedens Landing: Cheer Hall, Ferry to Dobbs Ferry, the Methodist Episcopal Church, in 1935 it became the Yonderhill Antiques building; a picture of the 1866 Liberty Pole that replaced the original one erected in 1861 which symbolized opposition to slavery, it was struck and destroyed by lighting.

Piermont: a view of Ferdon and Piermont Avenues where Henry Ludlow operated a gristmill along the Sparkill in the early 18th century; Bogartown on Paradise Avenue; the new two-horse pumper and hose cart used in 1895 by Empire Hose Company No. 1; a 1920-view of Piermont Paper which merged with Robert Gair Company; the Piermont Pier and Ferry Slip where troops from Camp Shanks left from and returned to during WW II.

Sparkill: The 1908 VanSciver House on Main Street also known as Hudson House Hotel and later the Sugar Loaf Hotel and Café; the Sparkill Grammar School built in 1900, with its interesting entrance and exit to the school for students living on the west side of Rt. 9W -- an underground passageway to avoid the traffic; the John Pauling Engine Company with a team of horses and a c. 1901 fire engine; a 1930s view of three Orangetown Police cars parked outside of headquarters in Depot Square.

Pearl River: scenes include a map of Pearl River; the Aetna Sewing Machine Co. that Julius Braunsdorf (the Father of Pearl River) had built; the Pearl River Hotel; the 1894 Hunts Store, now Haderler Hardware at the corner of North Main and Central Avenue; the 1904 George Turfler home -- the land was purchased by Dr. Ernest Lederle's and became the home of Lederle Laboratories.

Orangeburg: the Orangeburg Fair was traditionally held on the Dodge family's Bell & Co property, horse racing was a popular event; Bell An's building where the acid-indigestion product was made; Rockland Psychiatric Center; Camp Shanks with scenes of soldiers arriving or departing by train.

Blauvelt: St. Catherine's German Catholic Church built on land donated by George Lediger; Lediger's store; Blauvelt Library; Camp Bluefields Rifle Range and later a girls' camp.

Grand View: Grand View Railroad Station; Lyall Hotel; Grand View Bight; Rockland Academy; the Grand View Hotel was renamed the Jewish Home for Convalescents; scenes of the building of the Tappan Zee Bridge and a view of the causeway.

South Nyack: a view of the Rockland Female Institute, modeled after Mount Holyoke in Massachusetts opened in 1856; men working on building the Gothic-style Bell Memorial Chapel – the chimes and a clock were installed in Grace Episcopal Church in Nyack after the Chapel was destroyed to make way for the New York Thruway.

This was a very interesting slide show; it brought back memories of the "Way We Were" to many of the members present.
